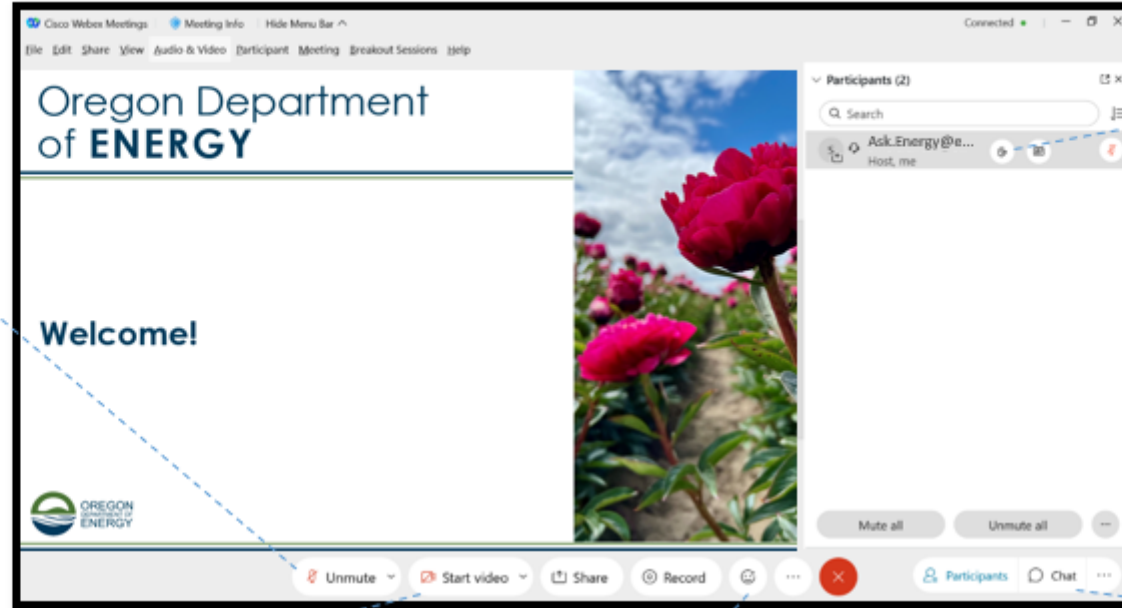

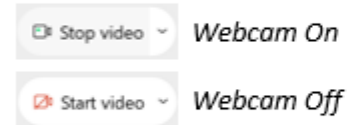

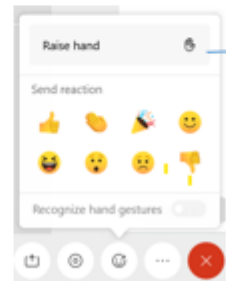

# Consumer Protection

---

- HB 4029 (2026) was effective June 5, 2026
  - Establishes consumer protections associated with the sale and purchase of residential solar energy devices

# OSSRP Update

---

- New Rebate Type:
  - Energy storage system that will be paired at the time of installation with previously purchased and installed solar electric system
- Now there are three rebate types:
  - PV Only
  - PV + Storage
  - Storage Only (has to be paired at the time of installation with previously purchased and installed solar electric system)

# Program Reopening

---

- Will begin accepting rebate reservation applications **June 15, 2026**
- \$1.1 million available:
  - \$550,000 for reservation for systems for low- and moderate-income households or low-income service providers, and
  - \$550,000 for reservation for systems for non-income restricted residential customers
