#### **ODOE-Hanford Update**

- ODOE submitted one comment letter to DOE
  - Comment on DOE 5-year plan 'placemat' document
  - Primarily comment on the presentation of information
  - Requested addition of 1) transuranic waste shipment preparation, and 2) Natural Resource Damage Assessment (NRDA) process
- Hanford federal funding
  - FY 2023: ~\$2.735 billion for combined Hanford offices
  - \$141 million increase over FY2022
  - FY 2024 request by Governors et al \$3.76 billion

    - Transparency in the DOE decision-making process, particularly for waste treatment and disposal decisions.
    - A safe transportation and disposal system for all types of radioactive waste.
    - Sufficient funding for DOE to meet annual milestones in state-DOE compliance agreements.
    - Long-term stewardship at sites where cleanup to unrestricted levels is not possible.
