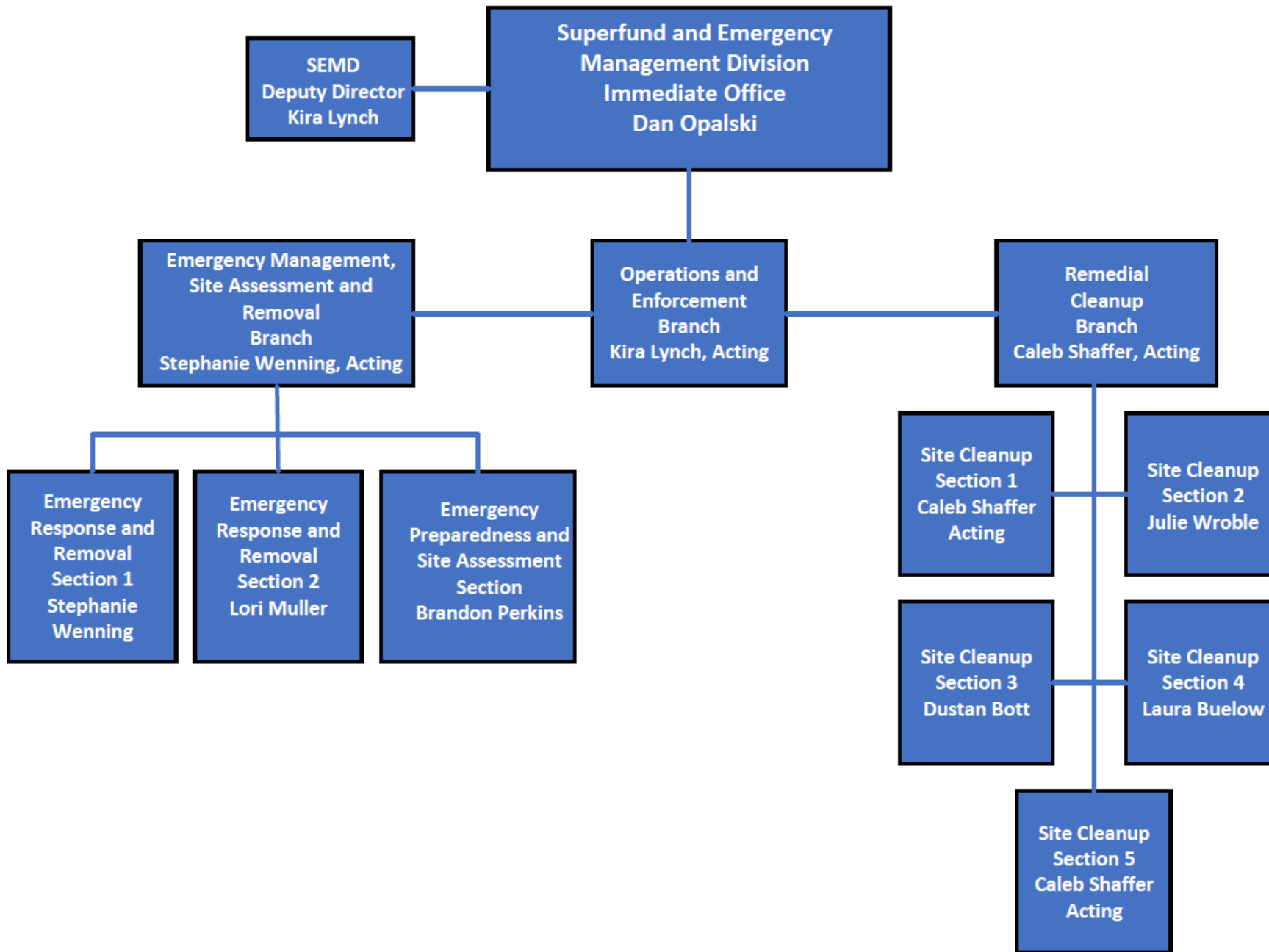

# EPA Recent Accomplishments

- ▶ 100-K Remedial Action Completion Report signed Feb 2026 for Phase 2 Waste Sites, documenting closure of 38 waste sites that had 476,696 tons of soil disposed of at ERDF.
- ▶ 200-BP-5 Remedial Action Completion Report signed March 2026, documenting the completion of well drilling and connection of extraction and injection wells to the Central Plateau pump and treat facility.

# EPA Near-Term Priorities

- ▶ Approval of major cleanup milestone package
- ▶ ROD Amendment for soil contamination under the 324 Building - June 2026
- ▶ Continued cleanup work at 100-K
- ▶ 100-BC Area: Remedial Action Completion at 100-BC-2 to document final waste sites close out and start benthic invertebrate sampling fall 2026
- ▶ 200-CW-3 Remedial Action Completion to document closure of 14 waste sites (Sept 2026)
