Incentives

Incentives are still in development. Information will be posted as the program progresses.

The development of incentive allowances will undergo a <u>formal rulemaking process</u> and there will be opportunity for public review and comment. Updates about the incentive plan and its development are posted on the <u>BPS website</u> and will be included in future BPS newsletters. <u>Sign up to receive BPS newsletters and email updates.</u>

Are there incentives? How do I know if I qualify?

There is approximately \$14 million¹ available for BPS incentives, but the incentive program is still under development. The incentive funds are as follows:

The state's general fund provides \$2 million for incentive funds.

- These funds can only be used for buildings whose Calculation of Energy Use Intensities (EUIs) are at least 15 points higher (less efficient building) than their BPS EUI target.
- If applicable, a Tier 1 building owner may be eligible for up to \$0.85 per square foot, and a Tier 2 building may be eligible for up to \$0.35 per square foot.

The remaining \$12 million in BPS funds comes from a federal Climate Pollution Reduction Grant and will have the same EUI and dollar per square foot as above.

- These funds can *only* be used for direct emission reductions, such as equipment and envelope upgrades and improvements.
- These funds may be up to \$250,000 per project.
