

Hunger Impacts

72% of people who receive food have
incomes below the federal poverty level



HUNGER AND HEALTH

Food pantry recipients suffer
diseases at rates higher than the
general public.

22% of food recipients are working full time.
16% are working part time.



48% of households receiving food
assistance have one or more
members with high blood pressure



HUNGER AND INCOME

income individuals and families to have
enough money to pay for food.
