## **Donor Impact**

- **2.2 mil** pounds of electronics, 17,293 tires, 950 appliances, and 21,434 pounds of hazardous household waste from local communities across Oregon were collected and properly disposed of.
- 10,000 linear feet of stream was restored in the Sandy River Basin, helping endangered fish with habitat structures and new access to half an acre of wetland habitat and side channels.
  - 1,000 Oregon residents were asked to take a pesticide-free pledge and were provided with resources through the Pesticide-Free Neighborhoods project.
    - acres of land were purchased from the McKenzie River School District for preservation, with proceeds of the sale used to fund scholarships for students living in rural areas.
      - early-career ecologists and one graduate student received training to help ensure the future conservation of native species and habitats in Oregon.
