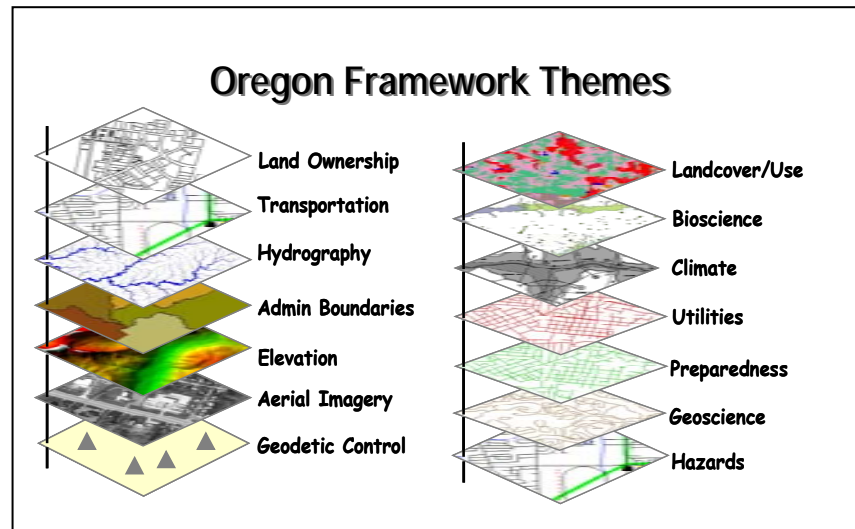
10th Framework Forum

The Forums are venues for presenting materials and methods relevant to Framework data development and use and for gathering vital input from GIS professionals statewide. Please join us and participate in the facilitation of Framework data development and Stewardship.

Highlights include a workshop to gather input for development of The Spatial Data Explorer, a collaborative effort including The State of Oregon and OSU to develop a website for the distribution of Framework data; a presentation by George Taylor, State Climatologist and two Standards presentations: The Oregon Fish Habitat Data Distribution Standard and the draft lidar Standard.

A short Framework Implementation Team (FIT) Meeting will convene at the conclusion of the Forum.
