Outcomes and Decisions

1. Quarter-quarters will be added to the geocoder at the request of Tanya Haddad and Emmor Nile
2. *Fire protection districts* will be assessed by the Administrative Boundaries FIT for inclusion in Oregon's Framework. Currently only forest protection districts and rural fire protection districts are identified as Framework data elements. The new assessment will examine the collection of existing Framework fire protection districts and non-Framework fire protection districts such as rangeland fire protection districts and structural protection districts. The Administrative Boundaries FIT will work with stakeholders to develop a recommendation for how to best meet community requirements for these data.
3. General agreement that standards continue to be a valid and important tool for Framework data development and management efforts. Standards while having considerable benefits including efficiencies related to integration and applications, standards also have disadvantages such as never fitting all users requirements.
