TAC Recommendation

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 276A.500-515, the Oregon Geographic Information Council (OGIC) serves as the statewide governing body for sharing and managing geospatial Framework data. In accordance to the statute, the TAC has reviewed the Public Review Tables and Summary and Methodology documents submitted by the Framework Program.

At this time the TAC provides a recommendation on proposed theme and data element changes that include:

- Theme name and description changes
 - Existing data elements with proposed changes
 - New framework data elements
 - Existing framework data elements with no changes proposed
1. The TAC Recommends OGIC's endorsement for Proposed Theme Changes and Descriptions (Table 1 in public review documents) with the following changes:
 - a. Address Point Theme Name be change to "Addresses and Buildings".
 2. The TAC Recommends OGIC's endorsement for Existing Framework Data Elements with Changes Proposed (Table 2 in public review document) with the following changes:
 - a. Dam Facilities should move to Hydrography Theme.
 - b. Road Centerlines should be retained as the data element name.
 - c. Vegetation Line (Coastal) should remain in Administrative Boundaries.
 - d. Metro boundary data element should be included in Oregon Metropolitan Planning Organizations data element. Once consolidated, the Metro Boundary data element should be removed from the Inventory.
 - e. The Framework Program should make historic versions of census geographics including (tracts, block groups and blocks available).
 3. The TAC Recommends OGIC's endorsement for New Framework Data Elements (Table 4 in public review document) with the following changes:
 - a. Add Structural Fire Districts to Preparedness Theme with Oregon State Fire Marshalls Office as custodian and steward.
 - b. Add Water Rights to Hydrography Theme with Oregon Water Resources Department as custodian and steward.

4. The TAC Recommends OGIC's endorsement for Existing Framework Data Elements with NO Changes Proposed (Table 6 in public review document) with the following changes:
 - a. Update the inventory to reflect that Historic Sites are publicly shared.
 - b. Wildland Urban Interface Boundary should be moved to Administrative Boundaries theme and custodian should be updated to Oregon Department of Forestry (from United States Forest Service) upon statewide layer completion.

5. The TAC Recommends The Framework Program work toward releasing restrictions on the following layers:
 - i. Address Points
 - ii. Land Use/Land Cover
 - iii. Tax Lots

The TAC defers recommendations on the data elements proposed for removal or further consideration as discussions are still ongoing at this time. The Revised list of Framework Data Elements provided (Attachment C) captures only the data elements recommended for OGIC's endorsement as Framework Data Elements at this time.
