



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 18-16

OREGON HISTORIC TRAILS ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Oregon Historical Trails Advisory Council was created by executive order in 1998 to promote Oregon's 16 designated historic trails.

WHEREAS, the creation of the Council was the first step in the development of the Oregon Historical Trails Program, which established Oregon as the nation's leader in developing historic trails for their educational, recreational, and economic values.

WHEREAS, the Council and its members—as well as others across Oregon—have successfully fostered statewide and local programs and organizations that support and advocate for Oregon's historic trails.

WHEREAS, the Council has fulfilled its purpose, as set forth in Executive Order No. 98-16.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED AND ORDERED:

1. Executive Order No. 98-16, issued on August 11, 1998, is declared concluded and rescinded.
2. The Oregon Historical Trails Advisory Council shall be disbanded as of December 31, 2018.


