Dear Oregon Marine Board:

On behalf of Governor Brown's Regional Solutions Program in the Mid-Valley, I strongly support the Detroit Lake Marina's grant application for their pump out repairs and gangplanks. We are excited about the future opportunities at the marina and surrounding area. Our program looks forward to continuing to work with Scott Lunski as he makes investments to increase the marina's resiliency, which would benefit the entire region.

Our understanding is that the proposed investments would greatly assist the Detroit Lake Marina's operations become more resilient by enabling the marina to operate more reliably in the months of August and September. The U.S. Army Corp of Engineers lowers reservoir levels in the fall to make sufficient capacity for winter and spring runoffs as well as satisfy water orders downstream associated with hydroelectricity, agriculture, fish and wildlife, domestic, and industrial purposes. The certainty of the reservoir level in the summer months is also being negatively impacted by climate change effects. The marina's most profitable weeks are from July 1st to September 1st so if they could better ensure operations during that time frame and expand the apex by 30% it would make a significant economic impact to the Detroit Lake Marina and, even more stimulating, the entire North Santiam Canyon.

The Mid-Valley Regional Solutions Team has been significantly involved in community and economic development efforts in the Canyon for the last two years. The team will continue to be involved with the Detroit Lake Marina's plans, and we look forward to seeing the results of these investments and the strategic dredging of the marina in the near future. The resources made possible by this grant aligns with multiple Mid-Valley regional priorities, especially with engaging in local infrastructure assessments, expanding opportunities which highlight visitor hospitality amenities, and, most importantly, enhancing programs that encourage business retention and expansion. Please consider awarding the Detroit Lake Marina the grant to make this work possible and help actualize the region's priorities.
