



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26-02

EXPANDING STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED IN EXECUTIVE ORDER 25-32 TO INCLUDE LINN, POLK, UMATILLA, UNION, AND WALLOWA COUNTIES

WHEREAS, Governor Tina Kotek signed Executive Order 25-32 on December 30, 2025, declaring a state of emergency for Clackamas, Clatsop, Coos, Curry, Douglas, Hood River, Jackson, Klamath, Lane, Lincoln, Marion, Multnomah, Tillamook, Washington, and Yamhill counties.

WHEREAS, Upon review of additional damage assessment information to public infrastructure and state roads on the federal-aid highway system and the severe winter storms also caused disaster conditions in Linn, Polk, Umatilla, Union, and Wallowa Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tina Kotek, Governor of the State of Oregon, by virtue of the authority vested in me under ORS 401.165, do hereby find that a threat to life, safety, property, and significant damage to the state roads on the federal-aid highway system was caused by severe winter storms and have caused disaster conditions in the above-listed counties beginning December 8, 2025, and continuing through December 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED:

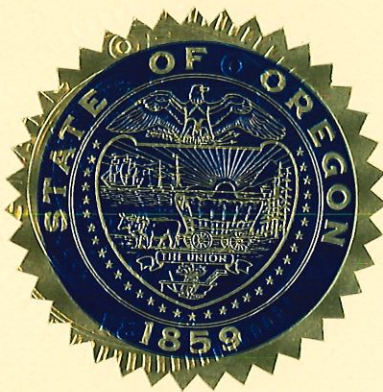
1. Executive Order 25-32 be amended to include Linn, Polk, Umatilla, Union, and Wallowa Counties.
2. The Oregon Department of Emergency Management (OEM). OEM shall activate the State's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and coordinate necessary access to use of personnel and equipment of all state agencies necessary to assess, alleviate, respond to, mitigate, and recover from conditions caused by this emergency. In conformance with the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and ORS chapter 401, state agencies are directed to provide resources and support requested by OEM to assist in the response to this emergency.
3. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). ODOT shall provide appropriate assistance and seek federal resources to effect repair and reconstruction for damages and impacts to the federal aid highway system in the above-listed counties.



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4. This declaration is not to be construed as a comprehensive declaration or proclamation of emergency for other purposes.
5. Duration: This order shall remain in effect through December 31, 2025, unless extended or terminated earlier by the Governor.
