The Heart of the Issue



- Culturally specific workforce is essential to Oregon's Behavioral Health goals
- Clinicians serve communities most impacted by disparities
- They take on multiple roles beyond traditional clinical care



Systemic Realities

• Unconscious bias affects policies, norms, and expectations.

• Cultural healing practices are often omitted from acknowledged models.

 Barriers in the traditional health care system can hinder people from accessing needed resources





Cultural Healing Practices

- •Communities rely on practices like barridas & limpias
- •Support emotional release, balance, and somatic regulation
- •System does not recognize or reimburse these modalities



Retention Crisis

- Bilingual/bicultural clinicians leaving faster than recruited
- Heaviest caseloads & most complex cases
- Least structural support and lowest compensation





Impact on Communities



- Loss of trusted providers reduces engagement
- Increased crises and unmet needs
- Greater disparities and service gaps



What Oregon Can Do

- Recognize culturally rooted interventions
- ·Address structural barriers shaped by bias
- Invest in retention-focused funding for cultural providers
- •Streamline pathways for licensing and supervision
