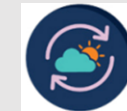

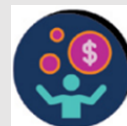

Tier 2

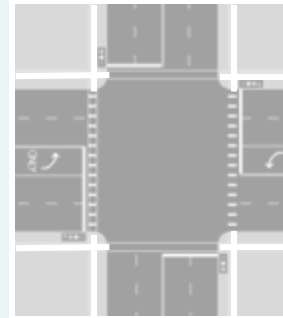

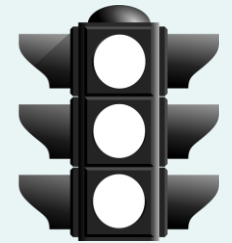

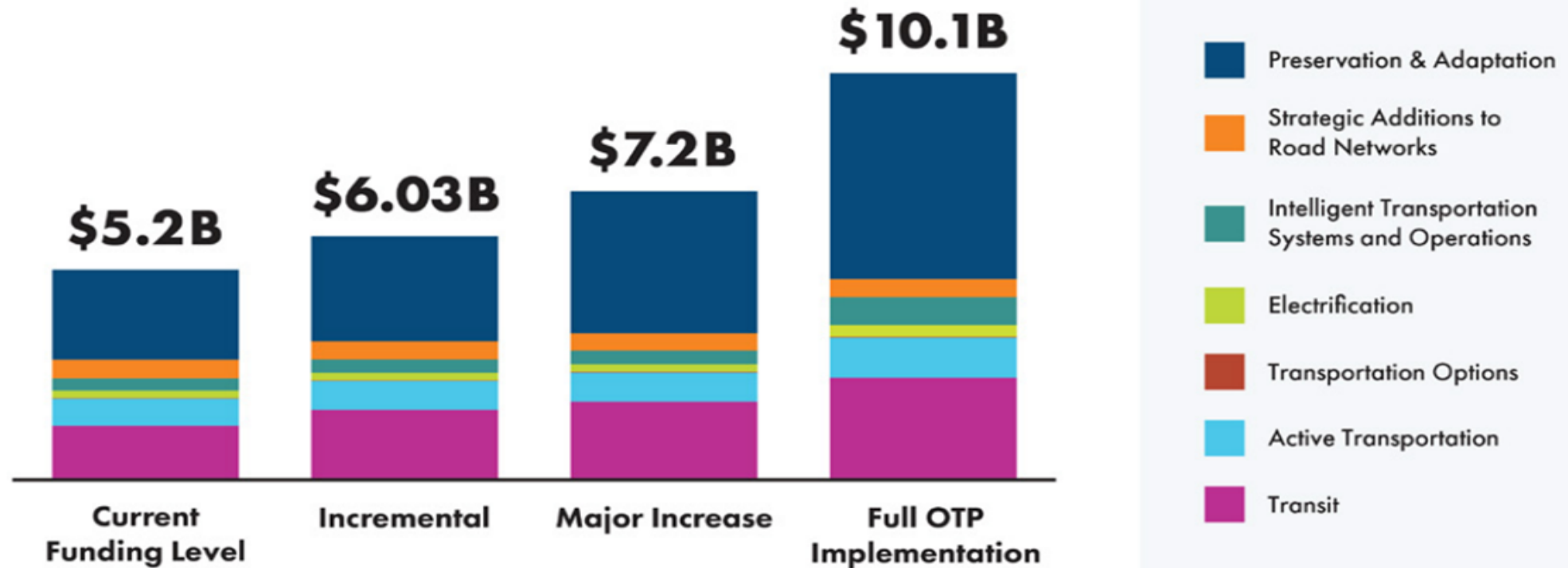
