


# LOCAL POWER UTILITY AND PSPS TIMELINES

- PRIOR TO PSPS, NO ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN PLANNING ACTIVITIES
- MAY 17 – FIRST INDICATION OF POTENTIAL PSPS IN SW OREGON
- MAY 23 – PACIFIC POWER HOSTED FIRST MEETING WITH STAKEHOLDERS IN JACKSON & JOSEPHINE COUNTIES
- JUNE 1 – WILDFIRE MITIGATION PLAN, INCLUDING PSPS, IMPLEMENTED IN JOSEPHINE, JACKSON, DOUGLAS AND HOOD RIVER COUNTIES. ALSO THE START OF OFFICIAL FIRE SEASON IN SOUTHWEST OREGON.
- JOSEPHINE COUNTY CONSIDERED LITIGATION – OPTED TO PARTNER WITH PACIFIC POWER TO ASSIST IN MITIGATION OF LOCAL CONCERNS



# CHALLENGES

- TIMING – SHORT TIME FRAME, AT START OF FIRE SEASON
- CRITERIA IN DETERMINING FIRE HIGH CONSEQUENCE AREAS
  - BASED ON CALIFORNIA PROCESS THAT INCORPORATED THEIR LOCAL STAKEHOLDERS OVER SEVERAL YEARS DURATION
  - OREGON DID NOT UTILIZE LOCAL RESOURCES, REPORTS OR STAKEHOLDERS TO DETERMINE FHCA'S
- POTENTIAL PSPS AREAS (PDZ's)
  - USE OF THIRD PARTY WEATHER DATA TO DETERMINE PSPS CANDIDATES, NOT YET SHARED WITH LOCALS
- SHELTERING OF CITIZENS
  - RED CROSS WILL NOT ACTIVATE SHELTERS FOR PSPS EVENTS, COUNTY HAS NO SHELTERING CAPABILITY
  - RESOURCE CENTERS
- EDUCATION / OUTREACH – MANY CHALLENGES OF POWER OUTAGES IN SUMMER VS WINTER
- COMMUNICATION PROCESS– INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL
  - COMMUNICATION WITH PARTNERS AND WITH GENERAL PUBLIC
- LIABILITIES – ARE THERE ADDITIONAL LIABILITIES (AND TO WHOM) FOR INTENTIONAL POWER SHUTOFF TO CITIZENS?

# CHALLENGES RELATED TO DATA

- CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE VS CRITICAL FACILITIES
- INABILITY TO IDENTIFY POWER-DEPENDENCE CAPABILITIES OF CRITICAL FACILITIES
- WORKING WITH OHA TO LOCATE, SHARE AND MAINTAIN MEDICAL DATA
- MEDICAL INFORMATION RECEIVED BY COUNTIES STILL PROTECTED BY HIPPA

- JOSEPHINE COUNTY CREATED GIS SURVEY AND DATABASE FOR ALL FOUR COUNTIES



# RECOMMENDATIONS

- COORDINATE WITH LOCAL FIRE PLANS (CWPP's)
- STATEWIDE PROCESS TO IDENTIFY FIRE HIGH CONSEQUENCE AREAS
- STATEWIDE DATABASE FOR CRITICAL FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE
- STATEWIDE PROCESS IDENTIFIED FOR MEDICAL DATA
- FUNDING FOR ALTERNATE POWER FOR CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE (HOSPITALS, POLICE, FIRE, COMMUNICATION SITES, ETC.)
- INCREASED VEGETATION MANAGEMENT AROUND POWER LINES STATEWIDE
- HARDENING OF LINES
- CREATE SMALLER ZONES (THROUGH ENGINEERING) WITHIN PDZ'S FOR MINIMIZING IMPACTS OF PSPS's
- COORDINATE WITH LOCAL COUNTIES EARLY AND OFTEN
