




# OHSU COVID Forecast Oregon



Job Openings Labor Turnover Survey September 2021




#### **U.S. Teen Unemployment:**

U.S. non supervisory workers – July 2019 to October 2021



Average hourly earnings for leisure and hospitality workers have increased by 13% since November 2020.

At \$16.67, the average earnings is 3.8% higher than we would expect from the pre- COVID trend.

Pre-COVID, wages here were increasing by 4% a year. The last three months, wages have increased at an annual rate of 4%.






- The latest labor market data shows how COVID-19 continues to affect employment.

## **Oregon Recession Comparison**


Employment Percent Change from Pre-Recession Peak

January 2020 to October 2021




#### **Bend, Medford & Portland Metro Employment**

January 2020 to October 2021




#### **Unemployment Rate**









Declined by 40% since 1990




#### Population Age 65+ 1969-2019


## **Working Age Population**

Population Age 15 to 64: 1970 to 2020




# Working Age Population Growth

Population Growth 2010 to 2020 – Age 18 to 64 Estimates




#### **Workforce Age Growth by County**

Population Age 25 to 64: 2010 to 2019




# Youth Population Growth

Population Growth 2010 to 2020 – Age 0 to 17




