Southern Oregon Regional Priorities and Focus Areas

Appointed by the Governor, Regional Solutions Advisory Committees are composed of community leaders, including a Convener and representatives for cities, counties, businesses, sovereign Tribal nations, and philanthropic and community benefit organizations. Committees are tasked with identifying Regional Priorities for community and economic development, assisting with obtaining and connecting to resources and funding, and utilizing their local connections to advance regional efforts. Below are the priorities and tactics adopted by the members of the Southern Regional Solutions Advisory Committee on December 5, 2024.

Housing Production	 Promote innovative solutions to housing production: code amendments, community land trusts, financing options, etc. Land availability and readiness: address limited land supply and work on readiness of available land for housing.
