Commission Self-Assessment

Summary:

In September, 2017 HECC Commissioners were invited to participate in an online survey that served two purposes: 1) to establish how well the Commission is meeting standard board/commission best practices reported to the Legislature as HECC Key Performance Measure #16; and 2) to permit Commissioners to assess their service to and performance of the Commission, including through open-ended responses.

Nine of 13 then-serving members of the Commission responded to the survey. Commissioners' responses revealed broad satisfaction and gratitude for the work and development of the Commission, for their work as individual Commissioners, and for HECC agency staff. Some Commissioners expressed a desire to more deeply engage in the long-term issues facing higher education, including affordability and the work to accomplish 40-40-20, and to increase stakeholder involvement across the state.

Commissioners will review and discuss the findings.
