

**Docket Item:**

Institutional Snapshots

**Summary:**

To further the Commission's reporting goal, the Office of Research and Data has developed snapshots of higher education for the state, for the public university and community college sectors, and for each of the state's 24 public institutions. These snapshots are designed to provide consistent empirical descriptions of the state as a whole and of each public university and community college. They provide information on three primary aspects of higher education: enrollment, affordability, and completion, and they answer many questions frequently asked of the HECC. The snapshots are aimed at a wide audience, including the Commission, our institutional partners, members of the public (including students, families, and the media), the Legislature and other government entities, and policy makers in other settings. We plan to disseminate them widely as well.

We presented drafts of these snapshots at previous Commission meetings, and we have the final design now. Included here are the state, combined university, and combined community college sheets. Over the next few weeks, we will incorporate final 2016-17 degree data that will update these statewide numbers slightly and populate the individual institution snapshots.

The snapshots will be on the HECC website, each linked from a map of Oregon that shows all 24 institutions. They will also be available in printable, one-page versions and in a combined file. We plan annual publication with updated data each year.
