On May 11th, the summit will bring together leaders from business, workforce and talent development, education and other stakeholders. Attendees will hear about research findings on talent development, workforce skills and gather input regarding the future of Oregon's workforce.

The summit's key note speaker will be [Joseph B. Fuller](#), Professor of Management Practice and Co-Director of the Managing the Future of Work Project at the Harvard Business School. Harvard's multi-year initiative on the Future of Work and Fuller's research has probed the "skills gap". This work investigates the paradox that many employers have chronic difficulty filling jobs while millions of Americans remain unemployed, underemployed, or have left the workforce.

[Jamie Merisotis](#), President and CEO of the Lumina Foundation, will also speak at the Talent Summit. Merisotis is a globally recognized leader in philanthropy, education, and public policy. Since 2008, he has served as president and CEO of Lumina Foundation, an independent, private foundation that is committed to making opportunities for learning beyond high school available to all.
