Conditions:

1. Clarify guidelines for the sponsored dual credit instructor approval process. (SDC-F1)
2. Establish clear guidelines for assessment, and the extent to which LCC faculty provide guidance/oversight. (SDC-A3)
3. Include a Students’ Rights section in the Student handbook. (SDC-S3)

Lane Community College will submit additional Sponsored Dual Credit evidence for review and consideration, with a decision at the February 2019 Oversight Committee meeting.

Linn-Benton Community College

Sponsored Dual Credit “College Now”	Conditionally Approved
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Conditions:

1. Implement student course evaluation process and submit evidence of the evaluation and report documents along with a plan for using the results for program improvement. (SDC-PI1)

Conditions for Dual Credit “Excel”:

1. *Non-compliance policy is needed for instructors that do not attend meetings or submit necessary documents as required. Provide non-compliance policy, and evidence of how it was communicated to partner teachers/instructors. (DC-F4)*

Portland State University’s Dual Credit “Excel” will submit additional evidence for review and consideration, with a decision at the February 2019 Oversight Committee meeting.

Appeal from Sponsored Dual Credit “Senior Inquiry”:

While the Oversight Committee supports the Senior Inquiry program as a model accelerated credit program, there was considerable discussion as to whether it fits into the Sponsored Dual Credit standards. It appears to be a contracted college course being offered at the high school campus. The standards clearly indicate the sponsoring college is approving the high school instructors to teach the college course (F1, F2, F5, & F6). This determination was made primarily on the basis of how evidence described faculty relationships, more specifically 1) the non-formal manner in which high school teacher partners are recruited and selected and 2) how the responsibilities are shared. It appears that the responsibilities are so clearly delineated that the high school teacher only has responsibility for the high school content, and not for any of the college level curriculum.

Portland State University is submitting an appeal for Sponsored Dual Credit “Senior Inquiry” to the Oversight Committee for consideration at its February 2019 meeting.
