The proposed rule changes to the Barbers and Hairdressers Grant Program are a result of SB 1563, passed by the 2018 Legislative Assembly. The bill states that students who are not citizens or permanent residents of the United States are eligible to receive scholarships and other financial aid from the Higher Education Coordinating Commission. These changes reflect the new law. The other changes to the rules are to be more in line with current practice of the program. The HECC is also repealing the portion of the program that gives priority to full time students.
