The proposed changes to the Oregon Opportunity Grant Administrative Rules stem from HB 2407 (2015), which changed the awarding methodology of the Oregon Opportunity Grant from the Shared Responsibility Model to prioritizing students with the greatest financial need. The bill requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to report the academic success and performance of students beginning February 1, 2020. The bill also requires the HECC to design a method for evaluating success and performance. This amendment to the rule is meant to address the reporting requirements of HB 2407 (2015), by providing for the methods Commission staff shall use.

These changes go into effect on adoption.
