**Summary**

With the passage of HB 5202A (2022)(Section 455), the Higher Education Coordinating Commission will, subject to legislative Emergency Board approval, receive \$19M to establish the Oregon Tribal Student Grant (OTSG). New temporary rules are required with the development of the new OTSG grant program. The purpose of the OTSG is for the Commission to provide grants to offset the cost of attendance to any qualified student who is an enrolled member of an Oregon federally recognized tribe as defined under ORS 182.162. The rules establish definitions, student eligibility, application requirements, grant amounts, fund disbursement, concurrent enrollment, and record keeping requirements.

Current funding will support the program in 2022-23. The HECC will seek ongoing funding for the program during the 2023 legislative process.
