
Docket Item: 11.1– 2022 Report to the Oregon Legislature - House Bill 4059 (2012) - Credit for Prior Learning

Summary:

Oregon House Bill 4059 (2012) requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to submit an annual report to the Legislature that describes the progress made in achieving the goals outlined in the legislation. These goals focus on increasing the number of students receiving academic credit for prior learning (CPL), increasing the number and type of high quality CPL accepted by higher education institutions, developing transparent processes for awarding CPL, improving prior learning practices across institutions, creating tools to develop faculty and staff knowledge and expertise with CPL, developing articulation agreements for particular programs awarding CPL, and developing outcome measures and tracking progress toward goals. The 2022 report includes an overview of CPL in Oregon, data related to expansion and student outcomes, funding strategies to support expansion, and policy recommendations.

Staff Recommendation:

Approval of draft report, with HECC Staff authorized to finalize for Commission approval and submission to the Oregon Legislature in December 2022.

Recommended Motion:
