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Approval Process – 3 “Phases”



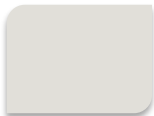
Phase One – Statement of Need



90 Day Waiting Period – Institutional Collaboration & Communication



Phase Two – Notice of Application (Program Proposal)



Final Program Refinement for Program Approval by Commission



Phase Three – Final Program Approval (Submission into Webforms)

Phase One – Statement of Need

Previously

- Staff recommends Commission “Approval” of Statement of Need and entry into 90 day Waiting Period

Moving Forward

- Staff updates the Commission on the receipt of a Statement of Need and notifies the Commission of the beginning of the 90-day waiting period

Phase Two – Notice of Application (Program Proposal)

Previously

- Staff recommends Commission “Approval” of Program Proposal and entry into the program Submission Process.

Moving Forward

- Staff updates the Commission on the receipt of Program Proposal and notifies the Commission of the program entering into the final phase of program approval.

Phase Three – Final Program Approval (Submission into Webforms)

Previously

- Staff recommends Commission “Approval” of final program submission

Moving Forward

- NO Change

Commission will receive two updates on BAS degrees prior to approval request

90 Day Waiting Period is a time for communication, collaboration, and coordination
