Strategic Capital Development Plan Status Report

Summary:

HECC is seeking an outside expert to develop and provide a 10-year strategic capital development plan to inform the prioritization of public university capital project funding requests. The most qualified consultant will have proven experience in educational strategic capital development, business consulting, analytic studies and surveys, and finance and economic consulting.

HECC has partnered with the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) Procurement to request proposals. The formal Request for Proposals (RFP) opened on July 11, 2018 and will close on August 22, 2018. Depending on the number of qualified suppliers, a contract could be awarded as early as this Fall. Once a contract is secured, consultant work will be conducted in coordination with HECC and University staff and the F&A Subcommittee.

DAS Procurement has identified 24 suppliers as of July 25, 2018 that have expressed interest in the Strategic Capital Develop Plan opportunity. Of those 24 suppliers, at least 10 are well known, reputable, regional or national firms. Interested firms will have an opportunity to learn more about the project and RFP process at a preproposal conference, scheduled for August 2, 2018.
