Due Date	Mandate
January 15, 2022	TC Submits first report to the Commission. Must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Report details subcommittees established to assist in CCN work -Establishes list of initial courses to apply 2023-2024 AY -Lists courses or other subject likely to be applied after 2025-2026 AY -List the courses or subject areas, which may include career and technical education studies, that the council anticipates adding to CCN after the 2025-2026 academic year
July 1, 2024	TC makes CCN final recommendation to Commission on establishment of CCN system
September 1, annually	TC will report annually to the Commission on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Progress toward enhancing and maintaining the common course, numbering system and any other transfer related work
Annually	Serve as main advisory body over Major Transfer Maps. One needs to be produced annually and is typically reviewed and approved every fall quarter. “Ensure the coordination, establishment, alignment, effectiveness and maintenance of foundational curricula [Core Transfer Maps] described in ORS 350.400 and unified statewide transfer agreements [Major Transfer Maps] described in ORS 350.404”

December 15, annually	Report annually by December 15th to interim committees of legislature on progress of CCN and other related transfer work starting 2022
Annually	Approves new AAT & AST degrees annually

Institution Timeline

Due Date	Mandate
Beginning of 2023-2024 AY	Each public post-secondary institution of education in this state shall be in compliance with rules for an initial common course numbering system by the commission
Beginning of 2025-2026 AY	<p>Each institutions needs to be in compliance with:</p> <p>(1) Adopt a common course numbering system, established by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission by rule, for introductory and other lower division courses with similar learning outcomes that are taught in accelerated college credit programs, public post-secondary institutions of education and participating nonpublic post-secondary institutions of education in this state.</p> <p>(2) Accept a transfer of academic credit for each course...as if the academic credit was earned at the institution that is accepting the transfer of academic credit with respect to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) The total amount of academic credit awarded; (b) Satisfying general education requirements for graduation; and (c) Satisfying any requirements for a major in a baccalaureate or associate degree program.
