(The questions are numbered in the PDF of the survey provided by HECC, but these numbers are not seen by the student in the online survey.) In this document, each question is referred to by its number in the PDF and by the code:

Section 1 asks questions about demographic identities. For questions in this section, if fewer than 10 students selected a response, the table will show “<10” for *n* and display “NR” (not reported) for the percentage.

Section 2 asks questions about experiences of different types of sexual misconduct. Sections 3-4 ask about disclosures and impacts of sexual misconduct. Section 5 asks about attitudes toward sexual misconduct, and beliefs and knowledge about their school’s responses to sexual misconduct. For questions in Sections 2-5, if fewer than 5 students selected a response, the table will show “<5” for *n* and display “NR” (not reported) for the percentage.

To help protect the confidentiality of students responding to the survey, responses to some questions are omitted from this report. These include the following:

Section 2A

Question 3 (REALD1): counts and text responses to racial or ethnic identity detail questions are omitted from the report.

Question 4 (PRIMID): if the respondent reported a primary racial or ethnic identity, it is omitted from the report.

Question 5 (GENDR): if the respondent wrote in a gender identity, it is omitted from the report.

Question 6 (GEND1): if the respondent wrote in a gender identity unique to their ethnicity, it is omitted from the report.

Question 8 (SEX): if the respondent wrote in a sex not listed, it is omitted from the report.

Question 9 (ORIEN): if the respondent wrote in a sexual orientation not listed, it is omitted from the report.

Question 15 (USCITSKIP): the count of respondents who opted to skip questions about citizenship is omitted from the report.

Section 2B

Question 69 (EXP2BSKIP): the count of respondents who opted to skip questions about times someone tried to communicate with them, followed them, tracked them, or watched them when they did not want them to is omitted from the report.

Section 2C

Question 83 (EXP2CSKIP): the count of respondents who opted to skip questions about experiences some people have had in relationships with intimate partners is omitted from the report.

Section 2D

NUNM Ethical Principles and Standards for Survey Administration

Purpose

This policy establishes the ethical principles and standards governing the administration of institutional surveys, including survey design, distribution, data collection, and data use. These

standards are implemented in accordance with applicable state requirements, including OAR 715-030-0010, and are informed by best practices in higher education survey administration.

1. Voluntary Participation and Informed Consent

Participation in institutional surveys is voluntary.

Individuals may decline participation, skip any question, or exit a survey at any time without penalty.

Survey communications clearly explain the purpose of the survey, how data will be used, and any relevant considerations for participation.

Participation or non-participation does not affect an individual's standing with the institution.

2. Respectful and Trauma-Informed Practices

Survey solicitation, recruitment, and dissemination practices, including any incentives used to encourage student participation (See [OAR 715-030-0011](#))

In accordance with NUNM's Ethical Principles and Standards for Survey Administration, the survey was distributed to students via institutional email. The invitation encouraged students to share their experiences and perspectives in order to ensure that student voices are heard and to support institutional reporting, policy development, and ongoing improvements related to campus climate and student safety.

Because the survey addressed topics related to sexual misconduct and campus climate, the solicitation language was written using a trauma-informed approach, acknowledging the sensitive nature of the subject matter and emphasizing that participation was voluntary. Students were informed that they could choose whether or not to participate and could discontinue the survey at any time.

To encourage participation, the survey invitation email was sent to eligible students with two reminder messages distributed at later intervals. The survey was administered anonymously, and responses were reported only in aggregate form to protect student privacy and confidentiality.
