OVERVIEW

The state of Oregon authorizes one high school equivalency test, the GED® test credential. The GED® testing process is coordinated and managed by the Oregon High School Equivalency Program staff. The GED® test serves as a bridge to higher education, trade schools, apprenticeship programs and employment opportunities for Oregonians who have not earned a high school diploma. Sixteen and 17 year olds may take the GED® test if they are enrolled in an approved Oregon GED Option program or exempted from compulsory attendance by a school district.
