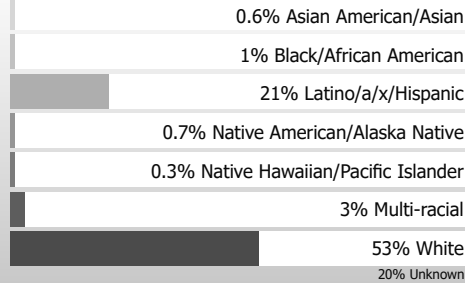

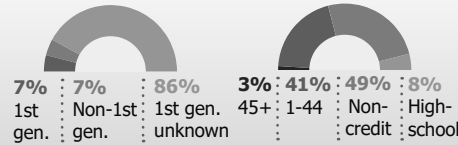

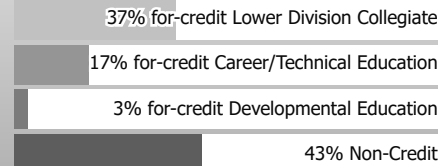


Students of color are increasingly represented on campuses. Currently, **27%** of TVCC students identify as students of color.

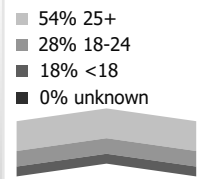
1st-Generation Status



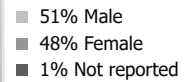
Primary Area of Instruction

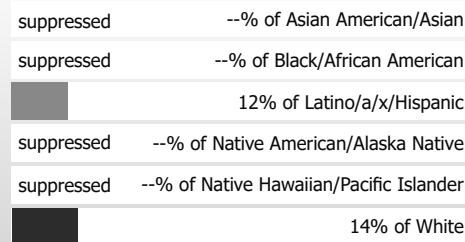

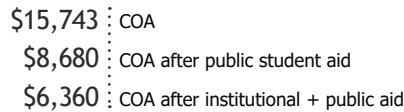

Average Cost of Attendance (COA)

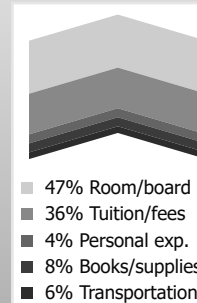


Time to Completion Increases Cost

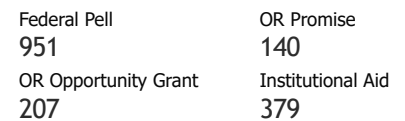

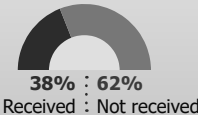

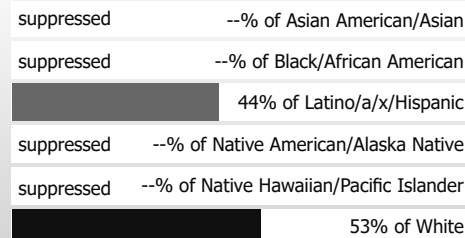

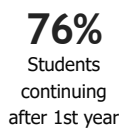

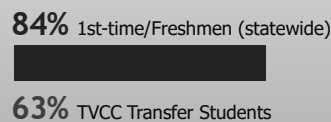
Completion Rates



Retention Rate



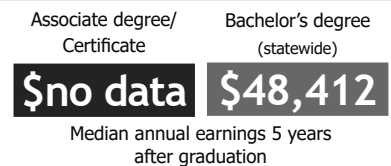
Bachelor's Completion Rate if continued to junior year
