


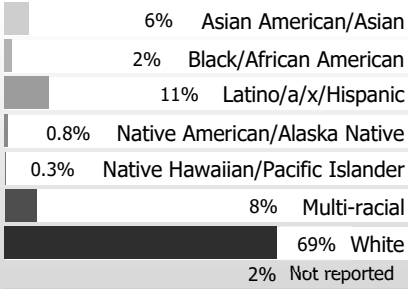

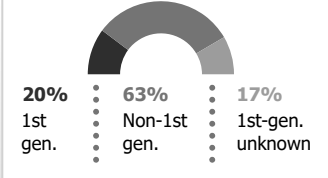
### Race/Ethnicity



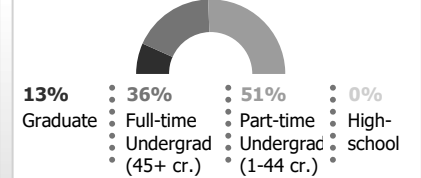
Students of color are increasingly represented on campuses. Currently, nearly **29%** of higher education students identify as students of color.

\*Used as total students for all metrics except Primary Area of Instruction, which also includes graduate students.

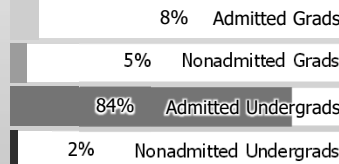
### 1st-Generation Status



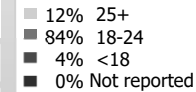
### Enrollment Level



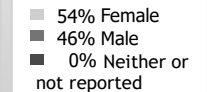
### Primary Area of Instruction (most credits)

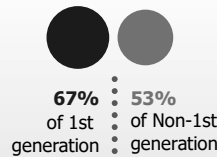
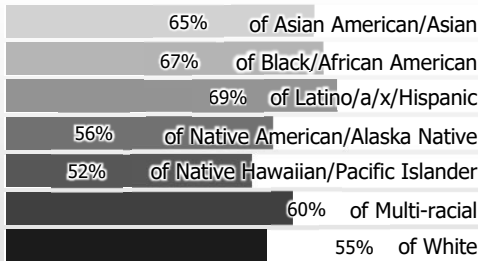

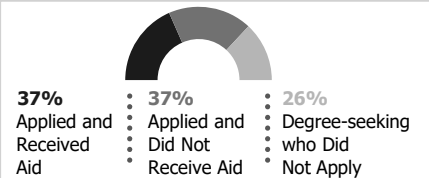
### Unable to Meet College Expenses with Expected Resources

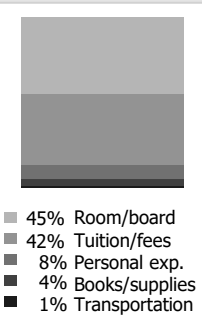

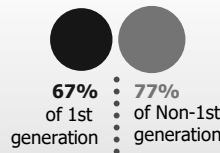
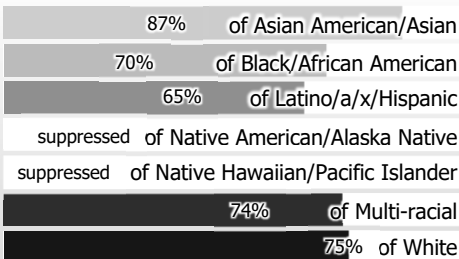
