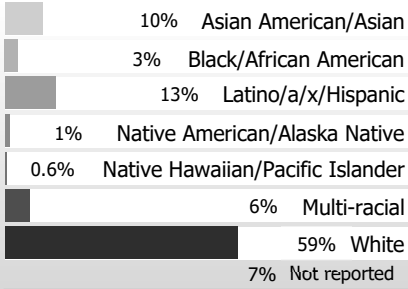

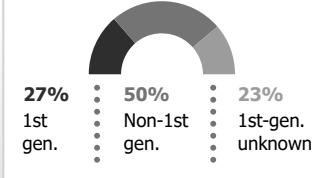
### Race/Ethnicity



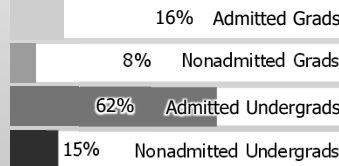
Students of color are increasingly represented on campuses. Currently, nearly **34%** of higher education students identify as students of color.

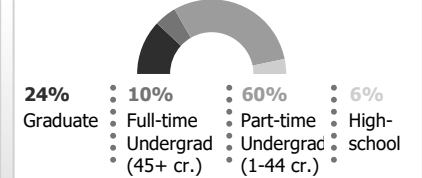
### 1st-Generation Status



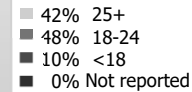
### Primary Area of Instruction (most credits)



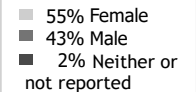

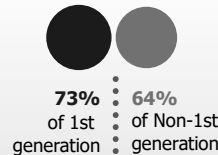
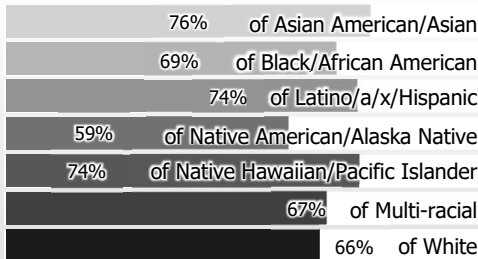

### Unable to Meet College Expenses with Expected Resources



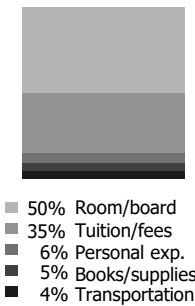

### Longer Time to Completion Increases Cost



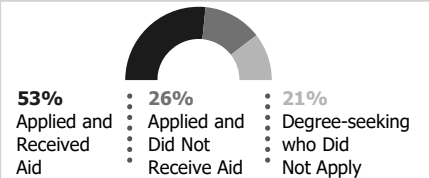

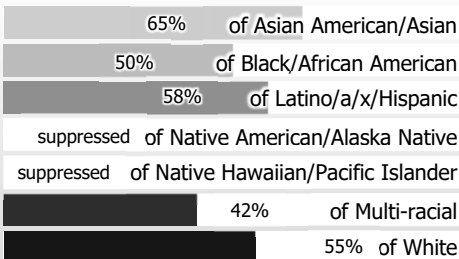

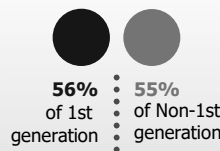
