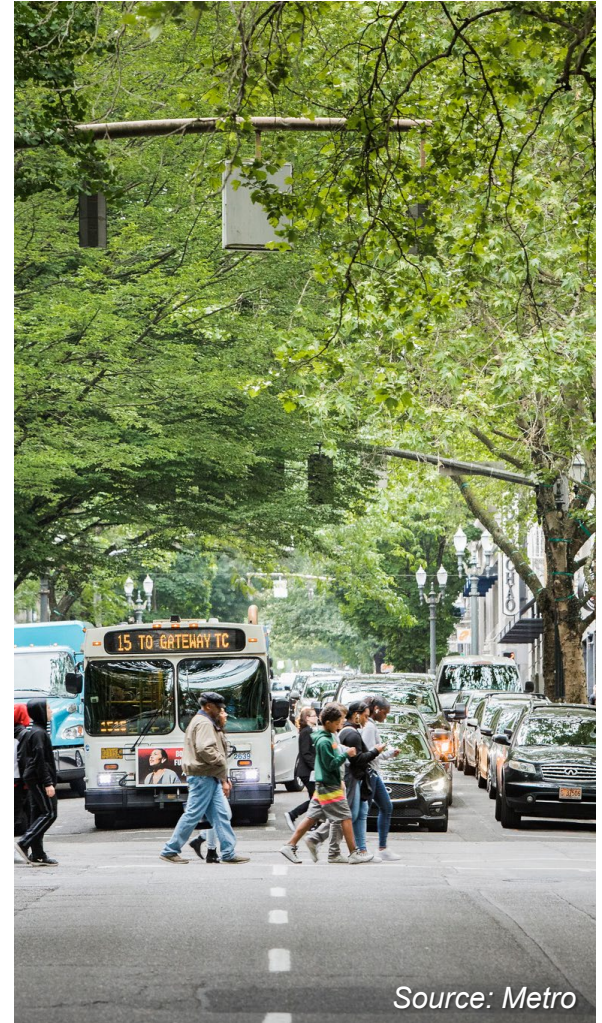

# Grants Overview

- ✓ Aim is to support local governments to implement the CFEC program
- ✓ No local match required
- ✓ Either grant (staff time or locally-procured consultant) or DLCD procured consultant



# Grants Overview

## Types of projects:

- ✓ Code audits and amendments aimed at fostering walkability and meeting urban design standards
- ✓ Parking reform and management
- ✓ Market studies to refine locations and sizes for climate-friendly areas
- ✓ Amending zoning for climate-friendly areas
- ✓ Equitable engagement
- ✓ Transportation system planning
- ✓ Other CFEC-related work





# Grants Overview

## **Eligible costs:**

- ✓ Direct project-related work
- ✓ Salary of staff
- ✓ Consultant fees

## **Ineligible costs:**

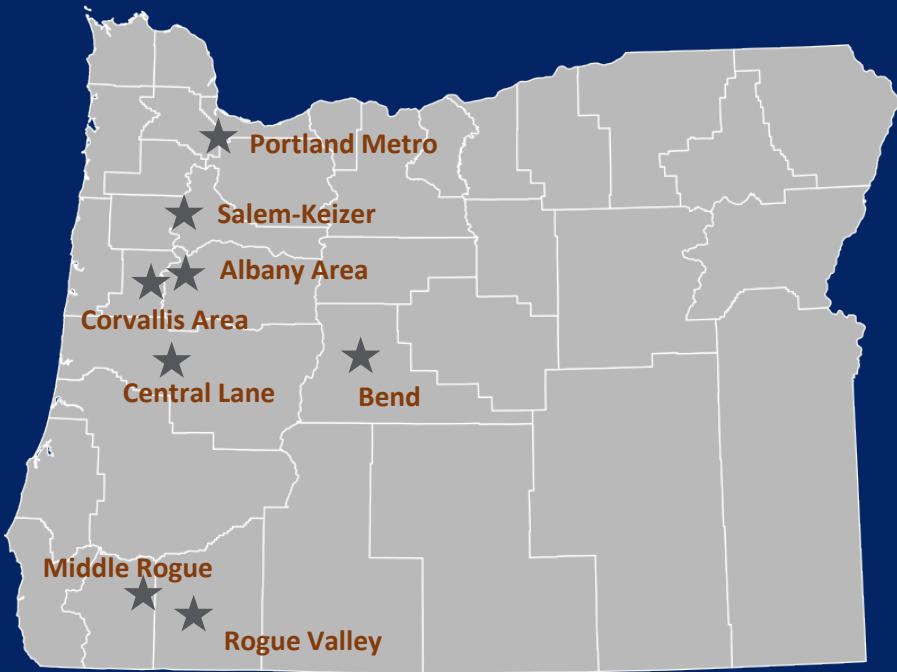
- ✓ Costs incurred prior to signing grant
- ✓ Equipment, software, etc.



# Key Dates

<b>November 27, 2023</b>	Application period opens; materials distributed
<b>January 23, 2024</b>	Application period closes; materials submittal deadline
<b>March 1, 2024</b>	Aimed-for funding decision; award notices sent
<b>April-June 2024</b>	Direct grant agreements anticipated execution
<b>May-August 2024</b>	Consultant contract anticipated execution
<b>June 30, 2025</b>	Funding expires

# Eligibility



## Grants program is limited to:

1. Cities and counties in the eight metropolitan areas included in the Climate-Friendly and Equitable Communities program
2. Work products that can be delivered by June 2025
3. Work products that reduce climate pollution or improve equitable outcomes



# Selection Factors

**DLCD will base awards on the following selection factors:**

1. Is the project work is required by rule? If not, how will the project reduce climate pollution or improve equitable outcomes? Will the project result in an adoptable product?
2. Is the project supported by city council, county commission, planning commission, other governing bodies, or community partners?
3. How will the project center voices of underserved communities listed in OAR 660-012-0125, or others?
