Exemptions Report May 17, 2023

For exemptions approved by the director as provided by OAR 660-012-0100(7).

About This Report

The report provides a summary of exemptions granted by the director as provided in OAR 660-012-0100(7). This provision gives some local governments the opportunity to request an exemption from certain requirements in the Transportation Planning Rules ("TPR", OAR chapter 660, division 12). This is like an existing provision for small-population communities that has been in TPR for decades.

This report provides a summary of exemptions granted to date. This report will be periodically updated as more exemptions are requested and granted. There is no deadline for requesting an exemption from the rules, nor any limit to asking for additional exemptions.

Approved Exemptions

The director has approved exemptions for nine jurisdictions. A complete summary of these approved exemptions is included in attachment A to this report. This is the third alternative dates report. The following jurisdictions have had an exemption granted under this provision since the second report:

- Polk County, an exemption granted on April 21, 2023
- Turner, an exemption granted on April 21, 2023

Expected Exemptions

The department is not presently in receipt of any other requests for exemptions. As requests are reviewed and granted, future versions of this report will include these exemptions.
