# Guidance for Technical Assistance Grant Applicants Regarding Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

Beginning in the 2021-2023 biennium, applicants in all Technical Assistance (TA) grant categories are required to propose outreach and community participation plans that reflect inclusion of priority populations identified in the <a href="State of Oregon Diversity">State of Oregon Diversity</a>, Equity and Inclusion <a href="Action Plan">Action Plan</a>. While local conditions vary greatly around the state, grant applications should describe the applicant's consideration of the following priority populations.

#### **Priority Populations**

- Black or African American community members
- Indigenous Native American or Native Alaskan community members
- Persons of Color
- Community Members with Limited English Proficiency
- People with disabilities
- Extremely low income and/or homeless community members
- Other locally identified underserved priority populations

### Required Equity and Inclusion Deliverables

All applications should incorporate deliverables related to inclusion and participation of priority populations. These deliverables should include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Identification of priority populations within the planning or project impact area;
- 2) A description of anticipated impacts and outcomes, including benefits to and burdens on priority populations that may result from the proposed project;
- 3) An outreach and public engagement plan designed to involve impacted priority populations, including specific goals for participation; and
- 4) A post-project evaluation of representation of and participation by priority populations in citizen and technical advisory groups.
