## **DLCD Racial Equity Framework:**

- Historical Inequities: What mechanisms under the jurisdiction of the Oregon Land Use Planning program can assist in reducing historical inequities related to public investments?
- Benefits and Burdens:
  - Partially-vacant land identified as development ready may put disproportionate burden on marginalized people.
  - o Identify possible unintended consequences. Infrastructure investments in an area previously neglected can compound displacement risk.
