Government to Government consultation meeting with Tribal Council April 9, 2025

DLCD staff met with Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Staff March 31, 2025

Tribes' concerns include/ not limited to:

1. Delegation from State to Local Decision-Making/Solar Siting Rules
2. Local Designation and Evaluation of Tribal Resources
3. Administrative Capacity/Adaptive Management

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Factors to consider:

State Government to Government obligations

Shared limited capacity (counties, Tribes, developers)

Other Goal 5 resources have been inventoried

Importance of confidentiality of archaeological and cultural resources

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Working draft recommendations to address concerns based on staff-to-staff coordination:

- Applicants notice DLCD in addition to SHPO, County, Tribe(s)
- Within the 60 days, if a Tribe indicates presence of non-inventoried cultural resources, counties may then, within the statutory 150-day time period:
 - Give tentative approval subject to agreement among parties
 - Initiate the Goal 5 process for adding a significant site to the local inventory and adopt appropriate protection measures as supported by an energy, environmental, social, and economic (ESEE) analysis]*
- If counties opt-in, they post the applications online; DLCD maintains a list of known / noticed applications on DLCD's website

* Need to resolve information custody/ confidentiality
