Dear Claimants:

On 10/27/2009, the Department of Land Conservation and Development (the department) mailed you a House Bill 3225 notification packet. This packet included a notice explaining that while you did not meet one of the original requirements of Measure 49, the 2009 Legislative Assembly had revised that requirement through House Bill 3225 (Chapter 855 (2009 Laws)). The packet also included a payment form. As explained in the notice, to be eligible for additional supplemental review under Measure 49 as amended, you were required, by House Bill 3225 and OAR 660-0410-0080, to return the payment form and \$175 payment to the department within 56 days of the date of the notice.

The 56-day response period ended on 12/22/2009. The department did not receive a completed payment form, payment or a request for an extension of time from you by that date. Therefore, you are not eligible for additional supplemental review of claim number E130016 under Measure 49.
