**RE:** Approval of Phoenix Urban Growth Boundary Amendment (Order 001932)

Dear Mayor Baker,

The Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) received a submittal on October 17, 2022, from the City of Phoenix and Jackson County regarding an amendment of the Phoenix urban growth boundary. The amendment removes approximately 50 acres and adds approximately 528 acres, including an approximately 250-acre urbanized area which was substantially damaged in the Almeda Fire. I am pleased to inform you that I have approved the amendment as provided in OAR 660-025-0150(1). This letter constitutes the department's order approving the amendment as provided in OAR 660-025-0175.

DLCD received no objections in response to the local government notice. Therefore, this order approving the amendment is final and cannot be appealed.
