NOTICE

Pursuant to 15 CFR Section 923.84 (federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations), the federal Office for Coastal Management (OCM) has concurred that the incorporation of the following statutes and administrative rules constitute "program changes" to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development's (DLCD) federally-approved Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP).

PROGRAM CHANGES

OCM concurred with the incorporation of the following statutes and administrative rules into the Program, with certain clarifications, qualifications, and exceptions as described in the OCM decision letter dated 6/8/23. These policies are effective for federal consistency reviews as of June 9, 2023:

- <u>City of Wheeler</u> Comprehensive Plan (2017), Zoning Ordinance (2018)
- <u>City of Tillamook</u> Comprehensive Plan (2012), Zoning Ordinance Chapters 151 and 153 (2020), Transportation System Plan (2019)
- <u>Tillamook County</u> Comprehensive Plan (2001) (as incorporated by reference in City of Wheeler Comprehensive Plan Goal 18 Policy 1E); Land Use Ordinance, Article III Zoning Regulations (2015) (as incorporated by reference in City of Tillamook Zoning Code 153.036);
- <u>City of Depoe Bay</u> Comprehensive Plan (2017), Zoning Regulations (2020), Zoning Maps
