Housing Planning Assistance:

Total Grant Fund: \$2.5 million

Application Period: June 1 – July 31, 2023

Eligible Projects: Develop, adopt, and implement plans needed to support housing production, affordability, and choice, including Housing Capacity Analyses (HCA) and Housing Production Strategies (HPS) under Goal 10 as well as updates to local development codes and comprehensive plans to comply with applicable state housing statutes and reduce regulatory barriers to housing production. Local governments not required by state law to conduct these planning activities are still highly encouraged to apply.

Housing-Related Urbanization Planning Assistance:

Total Grant Fund: \$1 million

Application Period: June 1 – July 31, 2023

Eligible Projects: Develop, adopt, and implement urbanization and public facilities plans to support development readiness or amend an Urban Growth Boundary where a housing need is identified.

General Technical Assistance:

Total Grant Fund: Approx \$700,000

Application Period: September-October

Eligible Projects: Competitive awards to local communities that fund projects to update a comprehensive plan, to update local land use ordinances, or other planning compliance projects. The grants must align with the priorities provided in the Grant Allocation Plan.

Transportation Growth Management (TGM) Planning Grants:

Total Grant Fund: \$2.5 million

Application Period: Open now, closing July 27, 2023

Eligible Projects: TGM awards two types of grants - Category 1: Transportation System Planning, to give Oregonians a range of transportation choices and meet requirements of the Oregon Transportation Planning Rules. Category 2: Integrated Land Use and Transportation Planning, to promote communities that meet the needs of all Oregonians to live, work, and move about

TGM Community Assistance:

Total Grant Fund: Approx \$750,000

Application Period: Rolling

Eligible Projects: Three categories of projects – Code Assistance Program: Code assistance projects typically address pedestrian-friendly design standards, mixed-use development, land-efficient development, housing, right-sizing parking, and development procedures, among other topics. Projects must further TGM objectives and cannot be solely housekeeping projects. Quick Response Program: Local governments and special districts can seek Quick Response assistance when faced with a development opportunity that could better address the community's vision for well-planned development served by a balanced transportation network. Education and Outreach Program: TGM makes private consultants on transportation and land use topics available to local governments at no charge. A typical Education and Outreach project includes site visits, community workshops, and a memo of recommended next steps.
