#### TO: ALL INTERESTED PERSONS

- 1. Effective June 15, 1998, the Land Use Board of Appeals is amending Administrative Rule 661-10-075(9) to reflect LUBA's recent change of address.
- 2. Statutory Authority: ORS Chapter 197.820(4).
- 3. Need for Rule: OAR 661-10-075(9) provides LUBA's address for purposes of receiving notices of intent to appeal and other documents related to land use appeals under LUBA's jurisdiction. LUBA has jurisdiction over an appeal of a local government decision only if a notice of intent to appeal that decision is physically received at LUBA's offices within 21 days of the date the decision became final. ORS 197.830(8).

On April 1, 1998, LUBA moved to a new address. Despite widespread notice of our new address, a number of appellants continue to send notices of intent to appeal and other documents to our old address, as stated in our rules and as published on our web page.

- 4. Documents Relied Upon: None.
- 5. Justification of Temporary Rule:

LUBA finds that following the permanent rulemaking process, rather than taking this temporary rulemaking action, will result in serious prejudice to the public interest because it will cause the following specific consequences:

LUBA's failure to promptly amend this rule will inevitably result in the dismissal of an appeal due to delay resulting from reliance on our published rules.

Delay in receiving other types of documents may affect the review proceedings in a number of detrimental ways.
