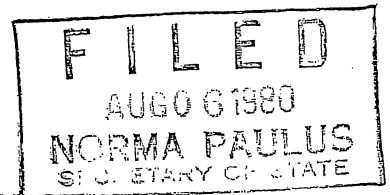

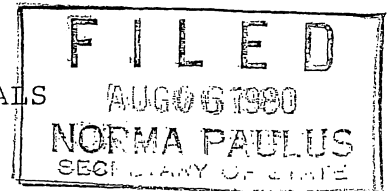

1. Statutory Authority: The Board has authority to adopt the notice rule pursuant to Oregon Laws 1979, ch 772, § 2(a)(4).

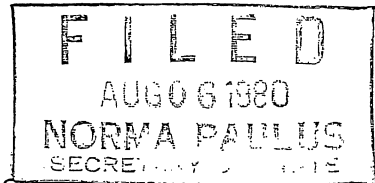
2. Statement of Need: The Notice rule is required by ORS 183.341(4).

NOTICE RULE FOR
THE LAND USE BOARD OF APPEALS

Prior to adoption, amendment or repeal of any rule, the Land Use Board of Appeals shall give notice of the intended action:

(a) In the Secretary of State's Bulletin referred to in ORS 183.360 at least 15 days prior to the effective date.
