1. The Land Use Board of Appeals Procedural Rules are amended by deleting the following sentence from Section 11:

"Where intervention is sought as a petitioner, the respondent or respondents shall have an additional ten days within which to file a brief in response to the motion for intervention."

2. Statutory authority: The Board has authority to amend its Procedural Rules pursuant to Oregon Laws 1979, ch 772, sec 2(a) (4).

3. The purpose of the amendment is to clarify an ambiguity which presently exists in Section 11 of the Board's Procedural Rules.

4. Documents relied upon: The Board relied upon its Procedural Rules in preparing this amendment.

5. Fiscal impact: The amendment will result in no fiscal impact.
