2 Respondent moves to dismiss this appeal and requests 3 forfeiture of petitioner's filing fee and deposit for costs 4 for petitioner's failure to file a petition for review. 5 Petitioner has not responded to the motion.

6 The petition for review in the appeal was due July 31, 7 1997. The petition for review has not been filed, nor has 8 an extension of time to file the petition for review been 9 granted.

ORS 197.830(10) requires that a petition for review be filed within the deadlines established by Board rule. OAR 661-10-030(1) provides, in relevant part:

"* * * The petition for review together with four 13 copies shall be filed with the Board within 21 14 days after the date the record is received by the 15 16 Board. * * * Failure to file a petition for review 17 within the time required by this section, and any extensions of that time under * * * OAR 661-10-18 19 067(2), shall result in dismissal of the appeal * 20 * * "

The deadline for filing the petition for review is strictly enforced. <u>Terrace Lakes Homeowners Assn. v. City</u> <u>of Salem</u>, 29 Or LUBA 532, <u>aff'd</u> 138 Or App 188 (1995); <u>Bongiovanni v. Klamath County</u>, 29 Or LUBA 351 (1995).

Because a petition for review was not filed within the time required by our rules, ORS 197.830(10) and OAR 661-10-030(1) require that we dismiss this appeal.

This appeal is dismissed. Pursuant to OAR 661-10-075(1)(c), petitioner's filing fee and deposit for costs are

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1 awarded to respondent.
