The county moves to dismiss this appeal on the basis that the petition for review has not been timely filed. The petition for review in the appeal was due February 11, 1998. The petition for review has not been filed, nor has an extension of time to file the petition for review been granted.

8 ORS 197.830(10) requires that a petition for review be 9 filed within the deadlines established by Board rule. OAR 10 661-10-030(1) provides, in relevant part:

"* * * The petition for review together with four 11 copies shall be filed with the Board within 21 days 12 after the date the record is received by the Board. 13 * * * Failure to file a petition for review within 14 15 the time required by this section, and anv 16 extensions of that time under * * * OAR 661-10-17 067(2), shall result in dismissal of the appeal * * *." 18

OAR 661-10-067(2) provides that the time limit for filing the petition for review may be extended only by written consent of all the parties.

The deadline for filing the petition for review is strictly enforced. <u>See Terrace Lakes Homeowners Assn. v. City</u> <u>of Salem</u>, 29 Or LUBA 532, <u>aff'd</u> 138 Or App 188 (1995); <u>Bongiovanni v. Klamath County</u>, 29 Or LUBA 351 (1995).

Because a petition for review was not filed within the time required by our rules, and petitioner did not obtain written consent to extend the time for filing the petition for review beyond February 11, 1998, ORS 197.830(10) and OAR 661-10-030(1) require that we dismiss this appeal and that
