2 MOTION TO INTERVENE

6 MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY REMAND

- 7 On August 17, 1998, the parties submitted a stipulated
- 8 motion to enter an order remanding the decisions at issue in
- 9 these consolidated appeals, and directing entry of a
- 10 stipulated decision pursuant to ORS 197.860. We granted the
- 11 motion August 18, 1998, by signing the stipulated order, but
- 12 we did not issue a final opinion and order to that effect, as
