2	Petitioners filed their notice of intent to appeal on September 7, 1999. On December
3	16, 1999, we issued an order resolving petitioners' record objections. The order required a
4	supplemental record from the county. On December 27, 1999, petitioner Phillips wrote to the
5	Board that the parties were negotiating the contents of the supplemental record.
6	Since that time, petitioner O'Sullivan has indicated that he anticipated that petitioners
7	would be filing a motion to dismiss the appeal. On June 28, 2000, the Board sent a letter to
8	the parties requesting a status update. The letter also advised the parties that unless the Board
9	received a response from the parties by July 12, 2000, indicating a desire to resume the
10	appeal, the Board would dismiss the appeal. The county responded, indicating that it
11	understood that one or both of the petitioners wished to withdraw the appeal. Petitioners have
12	not responded.
13	The above-captioned appeal is dismissed.
