You are entitled to judicial review of this Order. Judicial review is governed by the provisions of ORS 197.850.

The challenged decision is an ordinance, adopted as part of periodic review, that amends the county's comprehensive plan and zoning map to change the zoning of a certain property. On October 19, 2000, petitioners filed this appeal and at the same time filed objections with the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLDC). The parties then stipulated to stay this appeal pending completion of DLCD's review. The stipulation states that once DLCD completes its review, the parties will submit a proposed briefing schedule to LUBA.

On July 15, 2002, we wrote the parties asking about the status of this appeal. The county responded, stating that DLCD review has been completed, and that the county is prepared to go forward if petitioners still desire to do so. However, the county states that it has communicated with petitioners' attorney, who advised that his understanding is that the LUBA appeal had been dismissed, and that he no longer represents anyone in this case. Petitioners have not responded directly to LUBA’s July 15, 2002 letter.

Given petitioners’ apparent lack of interest in prosecuting this appeal, it is dismissed.
